A group show at CANADA will feature artists Demian DinéYazhi’ and Noelle Sosaya, MK Guth, Jessica Jackson Hutchins, Kristan Kennedy, Evan La Londe, Charlie Perez-Tlatenchi, Michelle Ross, Storm Tharp, and Heather Watkins. All of the artists are from the Portland area, and the title of the show is taken from Portland musician Elliott Smith.
