The curator Dan Nadel, whose portal to art was underground comics, has a superbly weird eye and a mind that works like a Venn diagram. The sixteen artists in "Samaritans," the split-level group show he organized at the Presenhuber gallery (on view through March 3), are united formally by their eccentricity and informally by their relationships. There are onetime highschool classmates (the painters Steve DiBenedetto and Ellen Berkenblit, whose "Captain of the Road" is pictured here), married couples (the sculptor Huma Bhabha and the painter Jason Fox, co-conspirators in gnarly aesthetics), and patron saints of the twisted (the polymathic cartoonist vibe of a what-if conversation about, to list a few of the show's subjects, past lives, extraterrestrials, and speaking in tongues.
