ART Elisabeth Kley and Tabboo!

Glazed earthenware fountains and trompe-l'oeil murals by Kley conjure a Roman courtyard—her inspiration was the garden environment of her friend Tabbool's apartment—setting the stage for a restorative show that celebrates the years-long collaboration of these two New York artists. Tabbool, a legendary drag performer, who is also a painter with a green thumb, has installed plants in the gallery's window, potted in charming vessels by Kley, near a wall here filled with a grid of his botanical watercolors. These playfully incantatory works on paper pairing leafy specimens with such evocative words and phrases as "ersatz" and "chef d'oeuvre." A selection of his small canvases includes the diabolically vibrant "Parakeets on Pink," in a wonderfully slapdash black-and-white faux-stone frame by Kley.
