Frye Art Museum

Grounded in a founding collection featuring European art from the late 19th and early 20th centuries, the Frye opened in 1952 and has grown from that initial collection from art collectors Charles and Emma Frye to works by a mix of local and international artists. Right now, you can catch New York artist Katherine Bradford's paintings in "Flying Woman: The Paintings of Katherine Bradford" (through May 14) alongside an artist-curated installation from the museum's collection curated by international research collective ESTAR(SER) (through Oct. 15) and an exhibition of work from early 20th century painter Marsden Hartley: An American Nature" (through May 21).
